Program Duration: June 4th, 2018 - July 21st, 2018

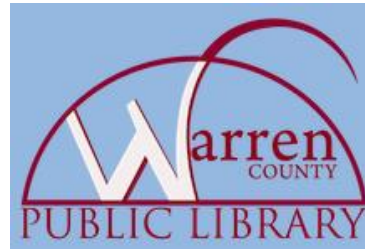
Adult Summer Reading Program:

Patrons 19 years of age and older are eligible to participate in the Adult Summer Reading Program. As a participant, you will receive a folder when you register, which holds detailed information about the Adult Summer Reading Program. It also contains all materials necessary to participate in the program, including reading logs and reading challenges, as well as a detailed schedule of events. Attending events, completing reading challenges, and keeping up with your reading log makes you eligible to win prizes at the end of the program. When you attend events, be sure to notify staff members at the circulation desk so that we can mark it on your participation card. Each person who participates in the Adult Summer Reading Program will earn a small prize upon checking in at the front desk after reading and logging 25 book titles. Patrons also earn prizes at the completion of each reading challenge. Prize levels vary depending on the difficulty of each challenge. See your folder for more details about the program and prizes.

Adult Summer Reading Raffle:

In addition to our full Adult Summer Reading Program, adults also have the opportunity to win prizes through our pre-established raffle. This time, however, attending events gives you an extra chance to win. Whenever you read a book, simply fill out a "Read for the Win" slip provided at the library's circulation desk and enter it in the raffle. You may also fill out a "program participation" slip when you attend an event and enter it in the raffle. So don't forget to fill out and submit your participation slips when you attend events! Participation slips will be available for patrons at every event on our Adult Summer Reading schedule.

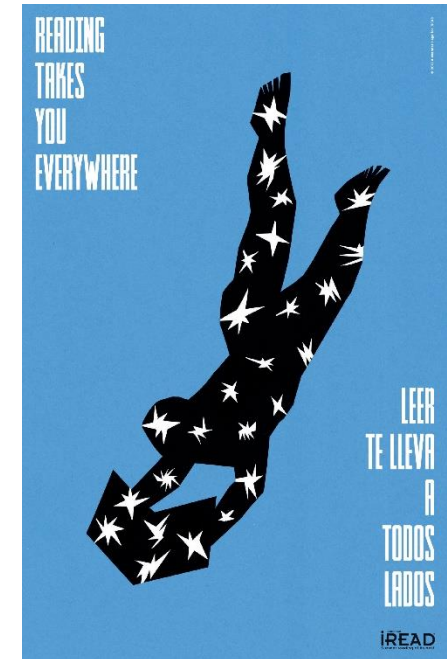
