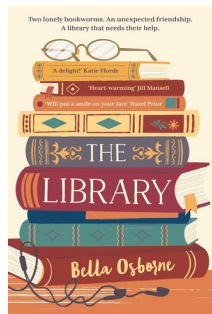
### BOOK DISCUSSIONS:
